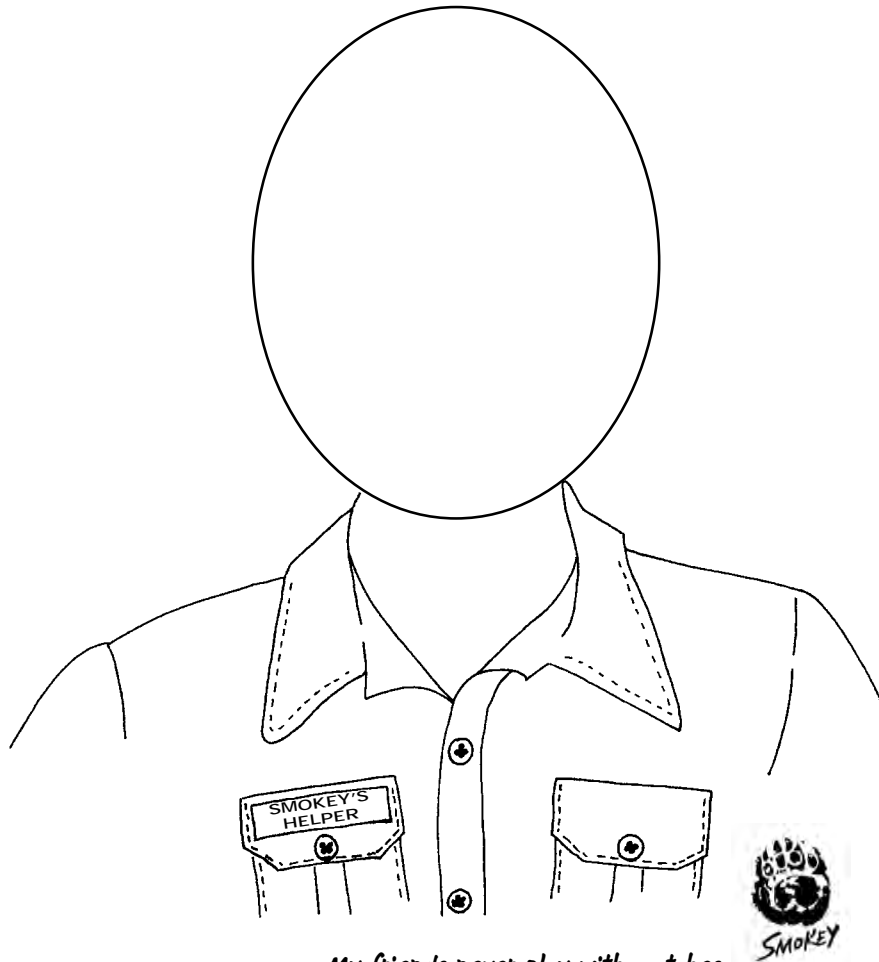

Firefighters work hard to protect trees, people, homes, and animals from wildfires. Thank them for keeping us safe!













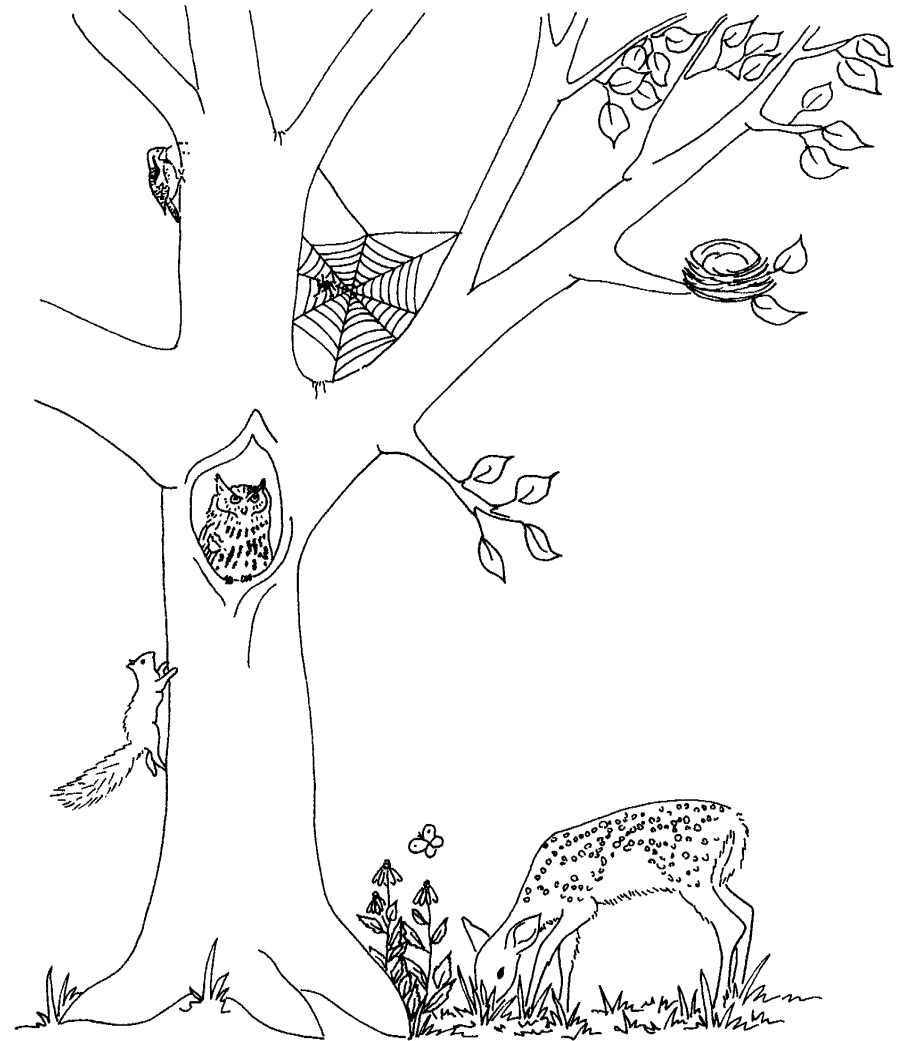
You can use your eyes to watch and your nose to smell. If you see someone playing with matches, tell a grown-up. If you smell a fire, tell a grown-up. Thanks!

Circle the ones that you find.

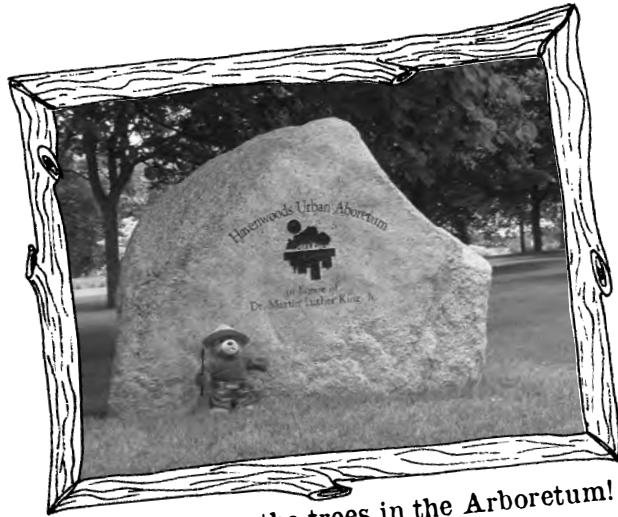


Wildfires caused by people can harm trees, shrubs, flowers, and grass. You can help me protect the places where animals live and find food.

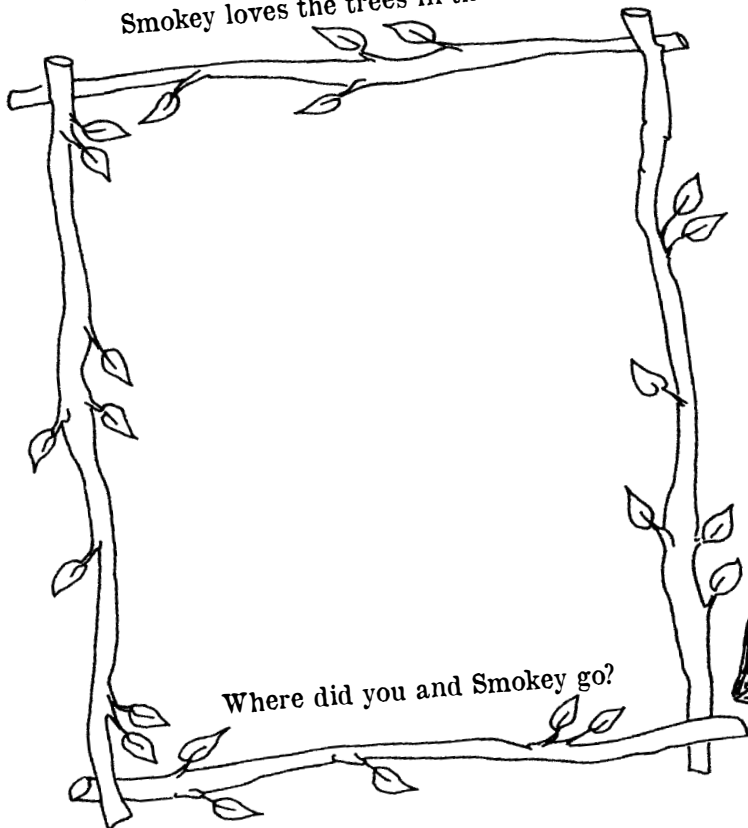

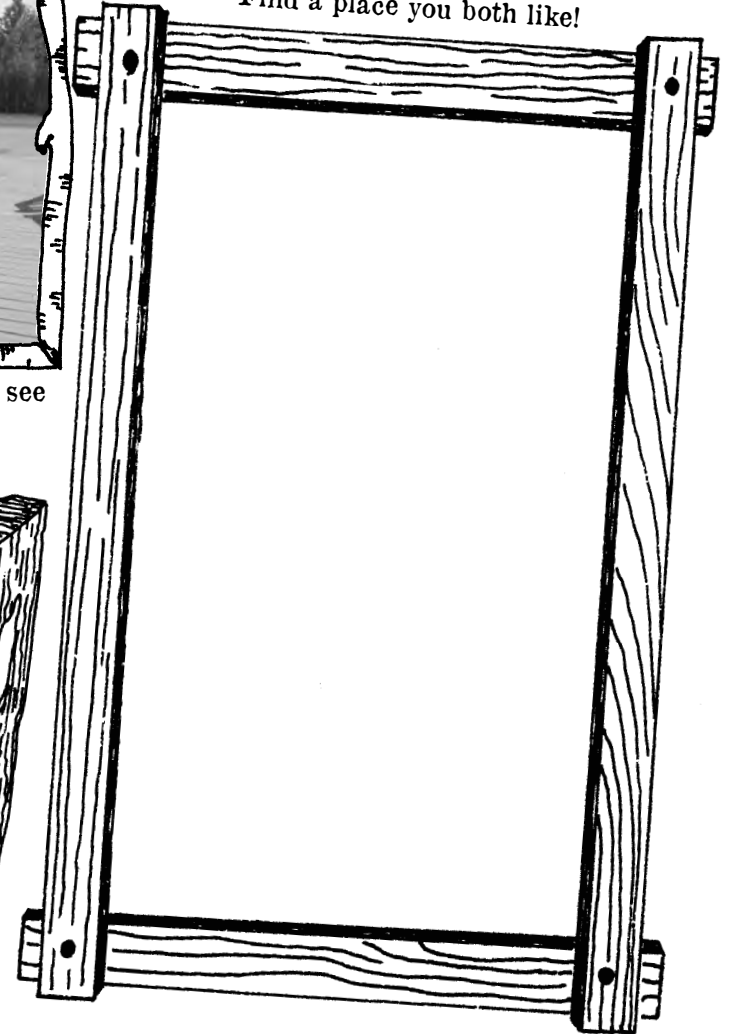
