# Teaching Materials

Havenwoods has many resources you can use at school or on a self-guided trip.

## Exploring Tools/Materials

### Magnifying Lenses \*

Take a close-up look at the world with plastic magnifying lenses.

### Binoculars \*

Search for birds and butterflies with 30 pairs of 10 X 25 binoculars.

### GPS Units \*

Find geocaches or make a map of Havenwoods. Eight units are available, grades 5 and up.

### Snowshoes \*

Strap on plastic bearpaw snowshoes to explore Havenwoods in the winter. We have two sizes of snowshoes, one size for kids (25 pairs) and one size for adults (10 pairs).

### Animal Footprints

Make animal tracks with 13 rubber footprints. Press in sand or mud or print on paper or fabric.



### Wildlife Guides

Search for wildlife using these 8-page booklets. They illustrate tracks and other signs of urban wildlife. Copy masters available, grades 1 to 6.

### Identification Guides \*

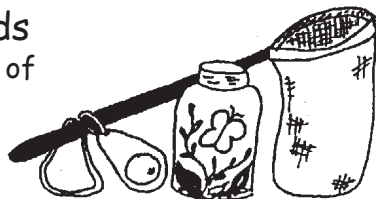
Borrow simple field guides for birds, animal tracks, insects, and butterflies and moths.

### Groundwater Models

Demonstrate how water and toxins move through the ground with an 18" x 24" model or a 3' x 5' model. A user's guide and lesson plans are available, grades 5 and up.

### Fish Printing Molds

Try the Japanese art of Gyotaku with six rubber fish on paper or fabric.



## Backpacks/Trunks/Kits

### Forest Forever ParkPacks

Borrow a backpack with activity cards, books, and teaching materials that focus on sustainable forestry. Two kits are available, each with materials needed for 30 kids, 10 to 16 years old.

### Great Lakes ParkPacks

Borrow backpacks with activity cards, books, and teaching materials that explore the ecology, history, culture, and geology of the Great Lakes. Four different packs are designed for use with small groups of kids, 10 to 16 years old.

### TreeSearch Eco-Explorer Kits

Discover trees with 13 engaging activities. Two kits are available, each with materials needed for 15 kids, 6 to 12 years old.

### World of the Whitetail Boxes

Explore the natural history, ecology, and management of whitetail deer in Wisconsin. The kit includes 24 teaching activities, deer artifacts, and numerous teaching materials. It is designed for classroom use, grades 6 and up.

### Mammals of Wisconsin Trunk

Investigate some of Wisconsin's most popular mammals along with several misunderstood ones. The trunk includes 16 activities, pelts, skulls, track molds, pictures, videos, books, and games, kindergarten to grade 10.

### Whooping Crane Trunk

Discover whooping crane ecology, biology, and reintroduction efforts through 14 hands-on activities. The trunk includes replicas, costumes, and other teaching tools, grades 4 to 8.

### Forest Products Pack

Discover the variety of products we get from trees through art projects, songs, and activities. The pack is designed to be used by small groups of kids, kindergarten to grade 3.
